Appendix 1: Tiny Dinner Safety Recommendations

PRIE Winery Tiny Dinners are small gatherings (20-30 people) that includes a light dinner, music, and social distancing.

This appendix provides suggested practices for increased workplace and after-dinner safety.

While at the Winery

1) Hand washing should be performed frequently

- a) Increase washing frequency based on your interaction with guests.
- b) Discard gloves and wash hands after cleaning restroom.
- c) Be careful when handling returned trays or glasses. Change gloves after handling items returned from guests. Note during dinners, guests provide their own glasses, and food items are delivered in disposable boxes. Nevertheless, if you are disposing of bottles, or assisting in purchases, increased hand washing is advised.

2) Do not touch your face, and personal items without washing your hands.

- a) Wearing gloves does not prevent transmission to you or others if you do not practice safe washing practices.

End of Shift Cleanup

1) Wash hands, face, and sanitize personal items (e.g., bag, phone, keys, eye glasses) before leaving.

2) Clothing, and shoes should be isolated and cleaned as soon as possible upon returning home.

- a) Change your clothes in one designated area of the house to minimize contact.
- b) Clothes should be immediately washed or stored in a separate area of your residence (garage, in the washer) until you wash clothes. Do not use the same basket to store dirty and clean clothes.
- c) Keep shoes by residence entrance, or wipe/spray with sanitizing solution/wipes.
- d) Sanitize your car's contact points (handles, controls).
- e) If you have a reusable mask, it should be washed or sanitized.

3) Shower before contacting others, handling food, or moving through your residence.

- a) When possible, use a bathroom not used by the other members of the family.

4) Report if you feel sick or suspect that you have symptoms of COVID-19 after an event to Winery management. This is important for contact tracing and informing others.
